What is Canberra Gang Show?

Canberra Gang Show is an annual theatre production and is part of the Scouts ACT and Girl Guides ACT program. It provides an opportunity for learning, developing and sharing theatrical skills, both on stage and behind the scenes. CGS 2018 has three goals for every member of Gang; to have fun, for each member to learn and to put on a good show.

What can you do in Gang Show?

There are lots of things you can do in Gang Show, from selling programs to sewing costumes, making props, building sets, hanging lights, playing in the band or acting in Cast. Gang Show is a training activity and can teach you the skills you need to fulfil your role. **See the application page for a complete list of positions available.** All members of Gang Show will participate in activities before and during theatre. What you do in Gang Show can also contribute to badge work –ask your leader or send us an email.

Who can join the Gang?

If you apply... you're in!! Canberra Gang Show is looking to have a Gang in excess of 150 people for 2018. To be in the Gang you **must** be a registered and financial member of the Scout or Guide Association in the following age groups:

Cast members	10.5 yrs - 30 yrs born between 30 June 1988 and 31 December 2007
Technical	14 yrs or older born before 30 June 2004
Front of House	14 yrs or older born before 30 June 2004
Security & Welfare	18 yrs or older born before 30 June 2000 – must hold a current Warrant
Parent Supporters	We welcome parents and friends as members to the support team.

Canberra Gang Show Performances will be in the second week of the July ACT School Holidays.

Members of the Gang that are 16 on or before 21 Jul 2018 will require a Working With Vulnerable People card (WWVP card).

Applications for Cast are limited to 75 persons due to venue limitations.

How do I apply to join the gang?

The cost of joining the gang varies by team due to the additional meals and activities provided for more intensive teams (i.e. cast). The fee also covers administrative expenses, the Gang Dinner, show shirt and after-party (for a full list, please visit our website).

All fees due to Gang Show must be made at time of submitting the application form by credit card. If you do not have a credit card, we recommend you purchase a prepaid visa gift card at your local shopping centre or post office.

Interviews

Interviews for all Cast members of Canberra Gang Show will be held on 17th & 18th of March 2018. This allows us to ensure applications are accurate, fees paid, WWVP cards completed, identification photos taken and to provide additional information about the show.

Parents of ALL NEW CAST Members under 18, must attend the interview. This ensures that parents and applicants understand the commitment required and to provide important information about the program. The details for your interview will be confirmed by 13th March.

The venue for Cast Rehearsals will be Mt Rogers Scout Hall, Charnwood. A full schedule is attached for your information.

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CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ADULTS IN GANG SHOW

This Code of Conduct is expected of all Gang members over 18 years of age (whether Rover, Leader, or Supporter), recognising that at all times they should act responsibly and exercise a duty of care to younger members of the Gang.

1. Adults in Gang Show respect the dignity of themselves and others.
2. Adults in Gang Show demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility, recognising that at all times their words and actions are an example to other members of the Gang.
3. Adults in Gang Show act at all times in accordance with Scouting Principles, thereby setting a positive example to all.
4. Adults in Gang Show do not use the activity to promote their own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are not compatible with Scouting principles.
5. Adults in Gang Show act with consideration and good judgement in all interpersonal relationships.
6. Adults in Gang Show respect everyone's right to personal privacy at all times. They take special care where the situation requires younger members of the Gang to change clothing or costumes.
7. Adults in Gang Show avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with younger members of the Gang wherever possible. Remembering, "in sight – out of hearing".
8. Adults in Gang Show, for their own protection, should avoid potentially compromising situations by ensuring, where reasonably possible, that at least two adults are in attendance whilst supervising and/or accompanying younger members of the Gang. It is recognised that, in certain circumstances, it may be necessary for an adult, whilst acting responsibly and exercising their duty of care, to be alone with a younger member of the Gang.
9. Adults in Gang Show realise that bullying, physical or verbal abuse, neglect or any other type of abuse, is unacceptable conduct.

RESPONSIBILITY OF ADULTS IN SCOUTING

The primary responsibility of adults in the Scouting and in Canberra Gang Show is the welfare and progress of Youth Members. The single most important function of the appointment process is to ensure, as far as possible that unsuitable adults are not given authority or control youth members.

Our program and our ethic requires us to provide an environment in which children and young people feel valued and secure and can grow as individuals, developing a sense of self worth, personal integrity and increasing competence through the acquisition of skills and achievements. Any adult behaviour, which is not supportive of this development process, is inappropriate.

Adults in Gang Show have a duty of care to keep Youth Members safe and protect them from physical and emotional harm. In our program activities this duty is exercised through a respectful, caring, empathetic and friendly relationship with young people. Adults in Gang Show have an opportunity to guide youth members in their personal standards, character and provide technical and practical skills in theatre craft.

An adult's peers and supervisors have a duty to ensure that our code of conduct is complied with. In any situation of doubt the Youth Member's safety and protection must be the deciding factor. No suspect situation must be allowed to continue in deference to the adult's rights.

Punishment

Adult Leaders do not have any right or authority to punish Youth Members. We do not stand in place of parents.

Discipline should be maintained through positive reinforcement (rewarding good behaviour). It should be bad behaviour which is criticised not the person. Sanctions can be by loss of privilege or exclusion for a short time frame from some enjoyable activity. Penalties should be avoided and any physical blow or force is assault and is a criminal offence as is any physical restraint, confinement, or interference with a Youth Member's clothing.

Touching

There can be good touching and bad touching just as there is good and bad language. A handshake is always acceptable while a hug is often unacceptable. Touch which gives offence or causes unease is not acceptable. A mature well-balanced adult will have no difficulty in determining what is acceptable.

Relationships

The Scout Association affirms a duty to its Youth Members for their welfare and development; adult Leaders accept a responsibility to the Association to care for Youth Members and deliver the program. Adult Leaders do enjoy Scouting and they do benefit from the training and experience it brings, but they stand on the other side of a dividing line where on one side Youth Members are entitled to benefits and protection and on the other, adults are part of the delivery process. The correct relationship between an adult Leader and a Youth Member is that of instructor, guide dispassionate friend and protector, very much like a teacher/pupil relationship. It is a position of integrity, trust and maturity.

Language

The Scouting ethic requires that we do not use bad language in our association with any members. There is nothing adult about frightening Scouts by swearing at them or trying to be ‘one of the boys’ by using foul expletives with youth members. Language should be acceptable to the reasonable onlooker and appropriate to the development of youth members.

Cultural

Scouting is a worldwide, multicultural movement. It welcomes people to membership irrespective of race, culture, creed or wealth. Youth Members are strongly influenced by the behaviour of adults. We need to be sensitive to the traditions and beliefs of various cultures and avoid words or actions which ‘put down’ any culture or peoples.

Harassment

Harassment is ongoing niggling or disparagement or belittling individuals and, for instance, includes a group of Youth Members excluding one from an activity or game. At its least extreme it breaks down the positive and protective environment we seek to develop and at its worst it is emotionally harmful. It is contrary to our objective of individual growth and development.

Child Protection

All adults in Canberra Gang Show are reminded of their responsibilities under ACT Scouting policy 10.9 and 10.10 relating to the compulsory reporting of child protection issues. Child protection training is a compulsory component of Adult membership

General Conduct

Adult Leaders should not:

- Show favouritism for particular Youth Members.
- Assist Youth Members with personal hygiene or dressing except where health or disability requires it and them only in the presence of another adult.
- Invite Youth members alone to their home.
- Have private talks with individual Youth Members away from the presence of other adults.
- Go on an activity with one Youth Member alone

General Duty

Each adult Leader’s responsibility goes beyond the confines of his or her specific appointment. Situations of inappropriate adult conduct or abuse can only be terminated by the intervention of another adult.
